

The 9/11 Commission — Some Context

Only after a full 441 days — and a long, hard fight by the Families Steering Group for an investigation — did an Investigation finally commence.

Initially, Henry Kissinger was chosen to head the Commission but promptly stood down following outrage from the Families' who were concerned with apparent conflicts of interest and subsequently had requested full disclosure of his business clients.

President Bush and Dick Cheney agreed to testify but only if together in a closed door session, not under oath and with no official records being taken of the discussion.

The man responsible for assigning the Commission staff's lines of enquiry (and therefore its most influential member) was Philip Zelikow, essentially a member of the Bush administration.

Having submitted hundreds of questions for investigation the Family Steering Committee were left with satisfactory answers to only a handful....with the large majority having not even been addressed and many of them key in ascertaining the true circumstances surrounding 9/11 and the true identity of the perpetrators.

Impartial Jury or Prosecution?

“Often, the truth about a criminal conspiracy comes out in the trial of the conspirators, where the public is presented with evidence and witness testimony. This time, though, there would be no trial: the nineteen perpetrators were dead, victims of their own atrocities . So we directed our team 1A to approach their task as if putting together the case against the conspirators.”
