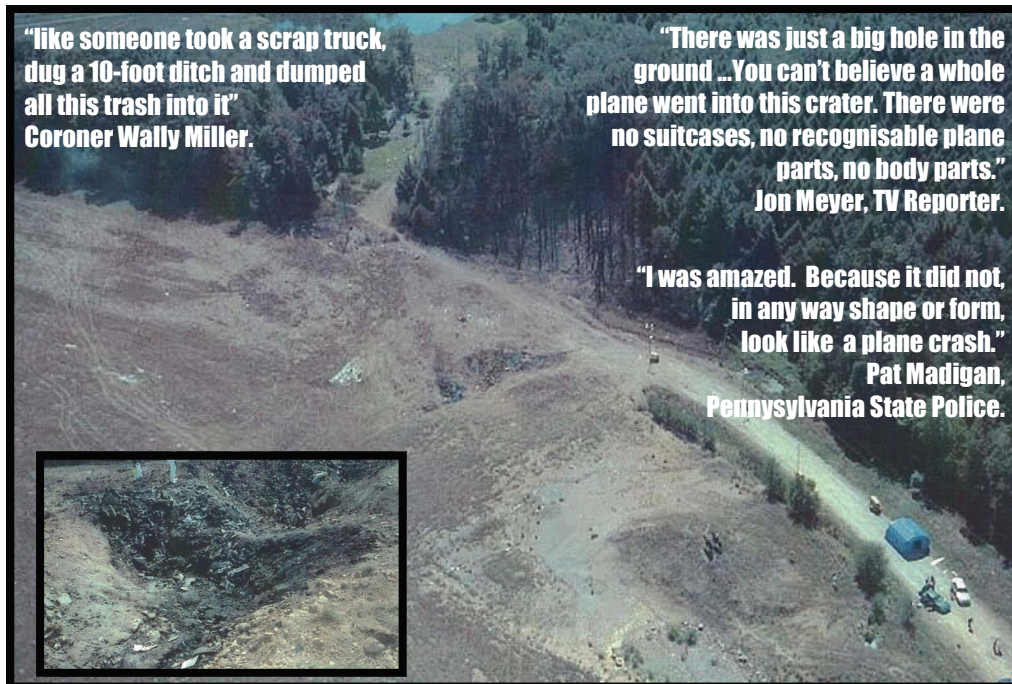


The Crash Site of Flight 93 in Shanksville



Numerous eyewitnesses to the scene described it as not resembling a crash site given the lack of airplane and body parts, various reports were received from witnesses having discovered pieces around 6 miles from the alleged crash site. Witnesses also came forward describing seeing "pieces falling from the plane" whilst in the air.

Investigators found a second debris field three miles away from the main crash site at Indian Lake, and a third debris field in New Baltimore, eight miles away **(a rather wide debris field for a plane that supposedly flew at a steep angle into the ground)**

The official story now has the plane's crash at 10:03 am (refusing to make its proof available) when many earlier reports stated a time of 10:06. Whilst not sounding like much of a discrepancy, this is very significant in terms of ascertaining the part in which the military played in this event in terms of its location in relation to the plane at the time as it has been confirmed by officials that shoot down orders were given.

We know that at least 25 mins before UA93 had crashed that Rumsfeld, Myers and Clarke knew about the hijacking. This leaves more than enough time to scramble jets to intercept. In fact, Deputy Secretary of Defense Paul Wolfowitz said that **"the Air Force was tracking the hijacked plane that crashed in Pennsylvania...and had been in a position to bring it down if necessary."**



Of course, we are expected to believe that a crash which supposedly buries the plane 10 feet into the ground — whilst disintegrating and leaving no recognisable debris other than charred aluminium — was able to leave this bandana unblemished. This item was later used in the trial of Zacarius Moussaoui in 2006.

Maybe this bandana is made from the same material as the alleged hijacker Satam Al Suqami's passport which, having escaped the fiery crash of Flight 11 into the North Tower, conveniently fell a few blocks away and unscathed from the huge ignition of jet fuel.
